Dear Parent/Carer

Re: PGL Residential – Year 4

We are pleased to confirm that the Year 4 residential trip will be going ahead again next year from Wednesday 5th – Friday 7th May 2027. This will be based at the Kingswood Activity Centre, which offers a variety of outdoor adventure activities. More information and detail of the trip will be shared in due course.

In previous years all pupils in Year 4 have attended this residential trip as part of their wider school experiences and this remains our ambition for this academic year. If you feel that this may raise issues for you or your child please contact us and we will be very happy to talk to you in confidence.

The total cost of the trip will be £292.50. As your child is entitled to Free School Meals, the government provide the school with funding in order to support your child's learning, development and experiences whilst at school.

We would therefore like to use some of this funding in order to create a more affordable cost for this trip. We would like to propose that we finance 75% of the total cost of the trip (£219.37). This leaves a balance of £73.13 for you to pay. This amount is based on the expression of interest, should children pull out of the trip the cost may increase.

Payment of the deposit is consent for your child to attend.

We ask parents to drop off and collect your child from the centre. This helps us keep the cost of the trip down in price. If your child is getting a lift with someone else, please let us know in writing or via the school office in advance.

If your child becomes unwell a few days before the trip, please call the school office to advise on the morning of their trip.

This has traditionally been a fantastic trip which allows the children to complete physical and team challenges that boost their self-confidence. It is a talking point of the year and we are committed to every child having this invaluable set of experiences.
