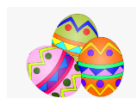

There is currently no vaccine for coronavirus.

However, there are things you can do to help stop germs like coronavirus spreading.

Do

Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze
