### **Term 6 2020/2021**

We cannot give you any further information regarding September, as we, as school leaders, also hear the news with the rest of the country through the Government Briefings, but as soon as we know, we will share our plans with you all.

As the summer holidays have not yet started, it is vital that all children are engaging with some form of learning, either formally (in conjunction with the school expectations and online offering) or informally (creating your own content) until we 'break up' from school officially on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July 2020.

We always expect a plateau of progress over the summer holidays, but there is a danger that this will be larger if work fatigue sets in now. I am however, reassured by the levels of interactions and work being produced by a large proportion of families. You will be contacted by a staff member during this term to see how we can support you in accessing the best learning for your child.

We have been working with the nurseries to support transition for our new reception children who should have now received a social story, books, paperwork and information for September. If you have any further queries, please contact the school office.
